MANAGEMENT OF COMPLICATIONS

- Intra- and Peri-operative:
 - Gastric perforations
 - Bleeding
 - Stapler dysfunction
 - ...
- Specific short- and long term-complications
 - Banding: Pouch dilatation, gastric erosion
 - Sleeve: Leaks, pouch stenosis, pouch dilatation
 - Bypass and BPD: Gastro-gastric fistula, gastro jejunal perforated ulcer, internal herniations
 - Severe GERD after sleeve
